

BYLAW 2008-01
A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH MAYOR AND COUNCILLOR'S HONOURARIUM
FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN

Whereas Section 17 Articles A and B of the Municipalities Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, CAP M-13 allows the Municipal Council of the Town of Georgetown to establish an honorarium for the Mayor and members of the Town Council and such additional amounts for the allowance of expenses incident to the discharge of their functions, be it enacted by the Georgetown Town Council the following:

1. Effective January 1, A.D. 2008 the Mayor of the Town of Georgetown shall be paid an annual honorarium of Three Thousand Ninety (\$3090.00) Dollars.
2. Effective January 1, A.D. 2008 each Councillor of the Town of Georgetown shall be paid an annual honorarium of Two Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Five (\$2575.00) Dollars.
3. Should less than a full year be served by any member of the Council, the salaries paid for that year shall be calculated and paid in accordance with the number of days served.
4. Payment of salaries shall normally be paid once per year, unless otherwise directed by Town Council, or may be paid on request, but in no case shall the amount paid exceed the amount earned based upon the number of days served at the time of payment.
5. An allowance for travel by private motor vehicle in the discharge of Town business shall be paid at the rate that is par with the rate set by the Province of Prince Edward Island per kilometer and be automatically adjusted to reflect such change in rate effective May 20, 2008; and an allowance for other expenses to the discharge of their duties may be paid on the actual expenses incurred. Payment of these allowances shall require prior approval of Town Council.
6. The Town of Georgetown Bylaw to Establish Mayor's and Councillor's Salaries April 18, 2005; and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
7. This Bylaw to come into effect at date of Second Reading and Resolution of Georgetown Town Council.
